
## **2022 BUDGET:** TOTAL: \$338,291

Lori's Hands relies on the generous contributions of individuals, corporations, and foundations to support our work, ensuring equitable delivery of services by not requiring participants to pay.

Program expenses include staff time spent enrolling clients and training volunteers as well as student scholarship and Sunny Day Fund spending. Administrative expenses include mandatory insurance coverage, financial management/audit services, and business registrations. Fundraising expenses include printing, postage, event, and marketing costs.

Growing financial support enables a growing program: from 2021 to 2022 our budget grew by 24% and our service hours grew by 84%

### PROGRAM GROWTH 2018 - 2022


